COVID Health & Safety Policy

In support of WCWI's efforts to create a safe environment for in-person conference attendees, we have been monitoring federal, state and local guidance on health and safety precautions and are in frequent communication with the management for each conference venue. Our goal is to ensure a safe learning environment for all, while welcoming the WCWI community to productive in-person gathering. We will continue to ensure the health and safety protocols for the conference are up-to-date based on current recommendations.

In-Person Attendance:

We are excited to gather again with the WCWI membership community, attendees, speakers, sponsors, and guests for WCWI's 32nd Annual Employee Wellbeing Conference. As wellbeing practitioners and leaders, all who attend will champion safe in-person gathering practices per the current recommendations and the venue policies.

As of the date of the most recent update: Milwaukee County is at medium community level. The guidelines are as follows:

- If you are at high risk for severe illness, talk to your healthcare provider about whether you need to wear a mask and take other precautions
- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
- Get tested if you have symptoms
- People may choose to mask at any time
- Attendees will hold the utmost concern for the safety and health of our peers by staying home if we are not feeling well

Onsite Safety Measures:

We are pleased to share that the hosting venues, the Wisconsin Center and the Marcus Performing Arts Center are following appropriate standards for health and safety.

- WCWI will work in accordance with local regulatory guidance at the time of the event.
